## *Guidelines for Abstract Format*

1. *All abstracts have a 300 word limit of text (not including presenter information and title)*
2. *Authors are advised to ensure that their abstracts meet the criteria and guidelines below. All accepted abstracts will be published as is. Acceptance of the abstract in the program and assignment to a session are determined solely by the Scientific Committee based on a review of the abstract and its subject matter. Abstracts are also subjected to editorial changes if necessary. Requests for particular types of presentations, sessions, days or time will not be considered, but last minute changes might be anticipated for special circumstance.*
3. *The forum Expert Committee invites the submission of abstracts of excellent quality in all areas related to minimally invasive gynaecology.*
4. *Abstracts may be accepted into one of the two categories:*
  - a. Oral presentation: the presenting author will be required to make a 15 minutes powerpoint presentation that concisely summarises the medical condition, the techniques used, the results and their significance.*
  - b. Video presentation: the presenting author will be obliged to present a 5-10 minutes video film preceded by a brief introduction in powerpoint presentation during the video film session to which it has been assigned. A brief abstract will be accepted for video presentation and a title only will be published in the conference proceeding.*

## *Format of Abstracts*

1. *The Scientific Committee has outlined the following guidelines for developing an abstract:*
  - Background:** *A statement of research*
  - Methods:** *An explanation of study design and methods used*
  - Results:** *A concise summary of the major findings*
  - Conclusion:** *Summary of the overall findings and importance.*

Forum Expert Committee

The Minimally Invasive Gynecology Forum Meeting is a platform for the Chinese doctors to gain overseas meeting experience, to present their achievements to their colleagues in the world. The Expert Committee was formed in 2005 to overlook the organization of these Forum meetings. The committee was pioneered by Professor Felix Wong who had witnessed the ever growing number of advanced endoscopy surgery in China, but due to limited opportunities for Chinese doctors attending international meetings, their skills are hardly recognized. Therefore the Committee, supported by a couple of Chinese experts, had organized its inaugural meeting in Anzhen Hospital, China followed by meetings in Sydney, Australia; Shenzhen, China; Auckland, New Zealand; and in Nanjing, China since 2005. These meetings had provided a great opportunity for the Chinese endoscopists to recognize WHO is WHO in Asia Pacific countries as well as to provide a forum for overseas experts to meet, to form social networks and establish a collaborative pattern with the Chinese endoscopists. The Committee would thank for the support of many companies in the endoscopy industries for their continual support and encouragement.



The Chinese Journal of Minimally Invasive Surgery

The editorial Board of The Chinese Journal of Minimally Invasive Surgery is formed from the Beijing University, China. The Chinese Journal of Minimally Invasive Surgery is the only regular Journal in China which reflects the development of minimally invasive surgery development. It covers all the minimally invasive surgical techniques in general surgery, cardiothoracic surgery, orthopedic surgery, bone surgery, neurosurgery, gynecological surgery, urology surgery, vascular surgery and cancer surgery. These include all thoracoscopy, endoscopy and interventional surgical technique. It is under the Chinese Ministry of Science collection of literature, CBM database and CMCC journal list. It is a monthly journal since 2005, and published on the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month with at least 80 pages.
